A lecture titled "Communal Affairs Over International Affairs: IR's Arrival in Late Colonial India" by Dr. Vineet Thakur, University Lecturer at the Institute of History, Lieden University, Netherlands was held on 23 August 2019 at Sapru House, New Delhi. Dr. Zorawar Daulet Singh, Fellow at the Centre for Policy Research, New Delhi, chaired the session. Explaining historical context of the arrival of International Relations discipline in India in the late colonial period, Dr. Vineet Thakur presented an account of events and personalities involved in the establishment of ICWA in 1943.
